

RESEARCH STUDY SEEKING PARTICIPANTS

Who is running the study?

Austin Speech Labs, a non-profit community clinic that provides speech therapy to stroke survivors, in partnership with Boston University.

What are we researching?

We are researching what language is most effective for providing language therapy to bilingual stroke survivors.

Who can participate?

Stroke survivors who are bilingual in English and Spanish (with any degree of proficiency for their second language).

What is the time commitment?

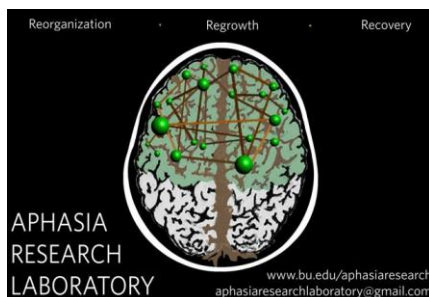
Participants will complete 14 to 20 hours of pre and post testing, and 4.5 hours of therapy per week for 10 weeks.

What will it cost?

Language testing and treatment are free to participants enrolled in the study. Treatment includes language therapy targeting word-finding difficulties.
